From the Pastor's Heart

I put myself in agreement with God's Word concerning you. That you are the head and not the tail, the first and not the last, blessed coming in and blessed going out.

GOOD REMINDERS

We need good reminders in our lives. They help us focus, remember, live better lives, be more organized, get things done, connect with our families and friends, do our jobs and the list goes on. Some of us make lists, others notes (but you have to remember where you put the notes), some use refrigerator magnets, some lay out the things they need for the next day, etc. We remind each other of things that need to be done, the "don't forgets" of our lives (brush your teeth, look both ways crossing the street, pray, read your Bible, be on time, call your _____, set your alarm.....)

We have so much to remember that we often forget even the most important things, even things we said "I need to remember this".

The Apostle Peter wrote this in II Peter 3:1 "Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in *both of* which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder). Most of the preaching, teaching, music and activities in the life of Charity Chapel are to remind us of things we already know.....I mean, it is important to know and worship the Lord Jesus Christ and to connect with him and demonstrate His words and life to others.

In our Charity Chapel Membership application is a declarations page that each official applicant signs as part of the membership process. It is good to remember these things, both if you are a believer and you know that God has put you at Charity Chapel. My prayer is that every believer will know their place in the body of Christ. Jesus is

***I purpose to be a faithful member in this local church and will honor God in my worship, my giving, my living, my sharing and my life.**

***I understand that if I willfully choose to not live by Biblical moral standards that I am forfeiting my membership at Charity Chapel.**

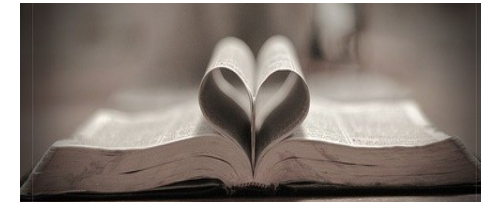
